Monday Meetings

- Monday meetings will start promptly at 7:30 pm and end at 9:00 pm. We ask that parents please come into the VFW at the end of the meeting when picking up their son. Sometimes paperwork may be handed out or there may be announcements about an upcoming event, but more importantly this is a safety precaution.
- Please come to Monday Troop meetings dressed in full Class-A uniform. This includes Scout shirt, neckerchief, belt, pants and hat.
- We will have parents meetings during the year which will be noted on the Troop calendar.

Overnights

- The \$10.00 for food will be due at the Monday prep meeting before the overnight. There will also be a sign-up sheet for each overnight at our first Monday meeting of the month. Anyone who shows up Saturday morning without having paid the \$10.00 at the overnight prep, the cost will be \$15.00. NO REFUNDS if you don't show up Saturday morning of the overnight without prior notification. An e-mail will be sent during the week before the overnight to everyone who is going on the trip. The reason for all of this is that we need to provide a tour permit to Council with the exact number of Scouts going on the overnight.
- Everyone will be required to attend 2 "real" camping overnights. (October, November, January, March and May). This requirement will reflect who will be eligible for consideration for next year's Charles Jefford's Scout of the Year award.
- Senior Patrol will coordinate and plan overnights on a rotating basis.

Registration Fee

The registration fee will be announced in early September or shortly thereafter. Payment of the registration will be due at the beginning of October. Families with two boys in the Troop will have a discounted rate for each boy.
