

TROOP 93 POLICY FOR BOARD OF REVIEW

A reminder to everyone exactly what is expected of you when you are ready for a Board of Review for rank advancement or making a presentation for your Eagle project.

FULL UNIFORM INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- ___ Scout shirt Have all of your patches on it—including Council Patch, troop number, current rank. Try to make sure that the shirt is clean. Make sure that your name is printed on the inside tag.
- ___ Scout pants Please make sure that they are clean.
- ___ Scout belt
- ___ Scout socks If you are wearing shorts, then Scout socks are required.
- ___ Troop 93 neckerchief With proper BSA slide or slide you made at Summer Camp. Make sure that your name is on the inside of the neckerchief.
- ___ Troop 93 hat Make sure that your name is on the inside band.
- ___ Pen
- ___ Make sure that your Scoutmaster's conference with the Scoutmaster is signed off in your handbook prior to your Board of Review.
- ___ Have enough change or a phone card in case you have to make an emergency phone call. A Scout is always prepared.
- ___ Binder that includes BSA membership card, rank advancement cards and blue merit badge cards. It is important that you keep all of these cards when you receive your badges and rank advancements at a Court of Honor. Please see the Mother's Club Chairperson if you don't have a binder. Make sure to set up a binder before your next Board of Review.

*All of the above must be checked off before you can have your Board of Review.

During your Board of Review, sit up straight and keep your hands out of your pockets. When speaking or being spoken to, look at the person in question. Remember, a Scout is respectful at all times.
